Those hosting Indiana ASA Championship tournaments are expected to promote these tournaments and make them a success, as no part of the bid will be refunded to those awarded these tournaments. The host will furnish a room at no charge to both the umpire-in-chief and the Indiana ASA representative and a minimum of two (2) rooms for umpires and additional rooms if no local umpires are available. A map to the fields and a list of hotels / motels will be included with the tournament rules and bracket which will be mailed to the teams after the entry deadline (June 15, 2008). Trophies and awards will be purchased through Indiana ASA at \$300.00 per set per tournament. This amount will be deducted from entry fees received by the Indiana ASA Junior Olympic Commissioner.

As evidence of good faith in presenting this bid, we hereby agree to tender cash, money order, or certified check in the amount of \$200.00 to the Indiana Amateur Softball Association, Inc., for each tournament. These funds will be due with the submission of this bid form. Bidding associations (municipalities) that operate on a "claim" system may submit a claim, along with this bid form, to the State Commissioner for his signature. In the event this bid is accepted and the bidding association fails to conduct the tournament, this good faith amount shall be forfeited to the Indiana Amateur Softball Association, Inc. In the event this bid is accepted, the bidder agrees to have the balance of the bid, based on the number of teams entered, deducted from the entry fees received by the Indiana ASA Junior Olympic Commissioner.

In the event the Indiana Amateur Softball Association, Inc., accepts this bid herein tendered, for value received and in further consideration of such acceptance, the undersigned association agrees to all terms, conditions, and all payments required. "Acceptance" of a bid shall be defined as a tournament actually being awarded by a Tournament Awards Committee. These terms and conditions include, but are not limited to, registering all teams and umpires that play or work at the host site with Indiana Amateur Softball Association, Inc., in the year the tournament is scheduled to take place. This shall be further documented by March 1, 2007, to the office of the State Commissioner, or the tournament(s) awarded will be withdrawn and relocated. The bidding association further agrees to meet all the requirements detailed in the Indiana ASA Bylaws, which are abbreviated on the "Bid Procedures" page of this packet.

In 2009 **ALL** Junior Olympic tournaments will be held July 10-12, 2009.
